Registration


In order to participate to the e-learning course, users first need to be registered.


To enter the e-learning course you have to follow these steps:

- 1. Open a web browser (Firefox, internet explorer, chrome etc.) and enter the web address http://thalys.gr/.
- 2. First you need to Log In. The button is on the right top of the screen. Fill in your "username" and "password" in the relevant fields and click on the "Log in" button.




In case you forgot your password, click on the link "Forgotten your username or password?" and follow the instructions.




Left-hand menu – another way to navigate in the course is the left hand menu that shows the course structure in a drop-down menu. Click on the page you want to transfer there.



The majority of micro-entrepreneurs generally do not know what financial concerns they may have to come across.


